Whilst-activity	<ol style="list-style-type: none">5. Asking the student to read the sentences6. Asking the students to pay attention on the underlined words7. Explaining them how to use the three context clues; definition, inference, and experience.<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Definition (it refers to sufficient explanation within the sentences and the meaning to be available). Example:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Teaching can be studied as an independent behavior separated from consideration of <u>didactics</u> that is the science or art of teaching.

	<p>(Here, didactic means science or art of teaching)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A <u>scientist</u> is an expert in one or more of natural of physical scient. (Here scientist means someone who expert in science) <p>b. Experience (this may be a direct experience or the one that easily imagined)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We walk <u>warily</u> across the ice-covered bridge. (Clue: ice-covered, so warily means carefully, cautiously) - Life on moon does not <u>exist</u> because there is no water and oxygen. (Clue: there is no water and oxygen. So, exist mean be real, having life). <p>c. Inference (meaning can be derived from clues that are available through educated guest)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The hotel has a very modern <u>comfort</u>. The guest like to stay there much. (Clue: like to stay there much, do comfort means having free from suffering, pain) - Domestic animal like cats, dog, and sheep trained to become man’s friends. They are <u>harmless</u> and do not attack man. (Clue: man’s friend and do not attack man. So harmless means do not intend to hurt someone. <p>8. Giving the students a list of sentences</p> <p>9. Asking them to find the meaning of the underlying words</p> <p>10. Asking them to explain the meaning of underlying words one by one until the rest.</p>
